Notes on determining the sectoral eligibility of an applicant

A *DueDil* (or equivalent) report should be obtained, printed and attached to this form in all instances (unless Applicant is unincorporated or a report is not available). If a unit performs activities falling in only two different *NACE* categories (the European Union's industrial classification system) there will always be one activity that accounts for more than 50% of value-added, except in the highly unlikely case that both of the activities in question have equal shares of 50%. The activity that represents more than 50% of the value added is the principal activity and determines the classification of the unit. In a complex case where a unit performs more than two activities falling into more than two different positions of NACE, with none of them accounting for more than 50% of value-added, the activity classification of that unit has to be determined by using the 'top-down' method, as described in *UK Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities 2007 (SIC 2007)*.
